

- Among the available fossil fuels, only natural gas contains less carbon than propane. With its short lifetime in the atmosphere and low carbon content, it is advantageous from an emissions perspective in comparison to other fuels in most applications.
- Propane's high energy density and portability make it an ideal fuel option for distributed generation applications, such as power to off-grid areas and as a backup energy source for hospitals, factories and telecommunication centers.
- Furnaces powered by natural gas or propane have the lowest emissions of greenhouse gases (GHG). Electric heat pumps, fuel oil

furnaces, electric baseboards and electric furnaces all produce significantly higher GHG emissions.

- Tank-less water heaters running on electricity have nearly three times more GHG emissions than those fueled by propane.
- Propane-fueled vehicles contribute up to 10 percent less carbon than equivalent gasoline or diesel vehicles.
- Propane is a domestically produced fuel, only about 10% of propane is imported from Canada and foreign countries.

BEHIND THE SCENE...MEET ROGER GREENAWALT

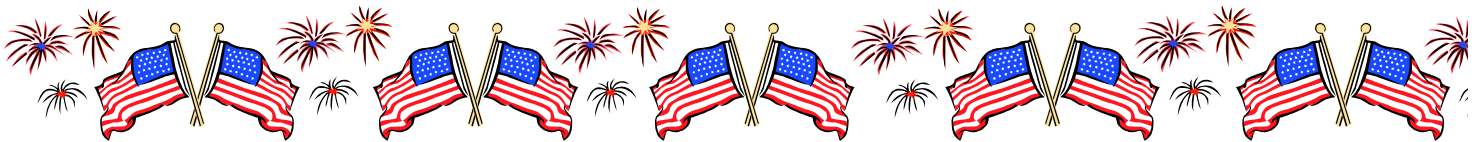

\$1,500 tax credit is available to homeowners who are replacing HVAC systems during 2009/2010.

In February 2009 Congress and the President passed the "American Recovery and Revitalization Act of 2009". This legislation made significant changes to existing tax incentives available to homeowners who purchase certain types of high efficiency HVAC systems. The tax credit (better than a deduction) has been increased to 30% up to \$1,500 of the total installed cost of the qualifying

system for 2009 and 2010. **Ressler Propane** has furnaces, central air conditioners, hot water boilers, heat pumps and even water heaters that qualify for these significant incentives. 1/2 c vegetable oil
1/2 c red wine vinegar or cider vinegar
1/3 c lemon juice
1/4 c Worcestershire sauce

2 Tbsp ground mustard
2 Tbsp minced fresh parsley
1 1/2 tsp pepper
1 tsp salt
2 garlic cloves, minced



In a jar with a tight fitting lid, combine all ingredients: shake well. Cover & refrigerate until ready to use. Use as a marinade for beef, pork, chicken, shrimp, or anything you can grill!
