

# **GRILL SAFETY**

Summer is here & so is grilling season. We want our customers to have an enjoyable experience when grilling with propane, and it is always good to be reminded of a few safety tips.

- The only safe location for a grill is outside in a well-ventilated area. Grills should NOT be placed directly under anything combustible or within 3 feet of the side of the house.
- As part of your startup procedures, be aware to open your grill cylinder valve slowly (clockwise) to prevent slugging the tank or gas line excess flow device. When not in use, turn the grill cylinder valve to the off position (counter-clockwise).
- Always keep the top open when lighting a grill.
   Do not use matches or lighters to check for leaks.

- Remove combustible materials or anything that could burn from cooking area.
- Always store and transport cylinders in an upright position (vertical). Do not store spare cylinders near a grill or another appliance.
- Never use a cylinder if it shows signs of dents, gouges, bulges, leakage or excessive rust. When in doubt, have the cylinder inspected by Ressler Propane.

Need to fill a cylinder, purchase an extra cylinder or have a cylinder requalified? Stop by Ressler Propane at 27 West Main Street in Mountville. We are open Monday through Friday, 7:30 am to 5:00pm.





- Grill tanks must be requalified 12 years from the original manufacture date.
- A grill tank requalification is good for 5 years.
