

WATER HEATERS BY RESSLER PROPANE



After heating and air conditioning, water heating is usually the largest energy user in the home. We all depend on hot water to keep ourselves and our homes clean and comfortable. With many choices for heating water today it is important to know which water heating equipment is best for your situation:

- **Gas tank type water heaters** – These water heaters heat a 40-80 gallon reservoir of water and store it. When hot water is used and the temperature in the tank drops, the water heater fires and heats the water back up. Many of these water heaters work without electricity and will still give you a tank's worth of hot water if the power goes out. Most of our customers using this type of water heater use less than a gallon of propane a day. This is the most cost effective water heating system for the average household.
- **Electric tank type water heaters** – These heat and store water in a reservoir just like the tank type water heaters. They cost less initially, but cost significantly more to operate than a gas tank type water heater.
- **Gas tank-less water heaters** – These compact, wall mounted water heaters don't store hot water, they only heat water when you are actually using hot water. Most models are electronically controlled and depend on elec-

tricity to operate. They usually use less gas than a tank type water heater, but cost 2-3 times as much to install and require professional maintenance for best operational efficiency. Our sales staff at **Ressler Propane** can help you determine if this would be a viable option for you.

CRUNCHY GRANOLA

Mix together the following dry ingredients:

| 6 c Oatmeal - old fashioned or rolled | 1 c Sunflower seeds - raw |
| 1 c Nuts - pecans, walnuts, or almonds | 1/2 c Coconut - optional |
| 1 c Wheat Germ | |

Mix together and heat the following ingredients until sugar melts:

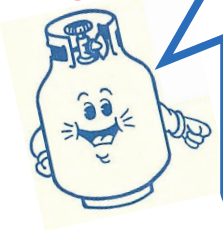
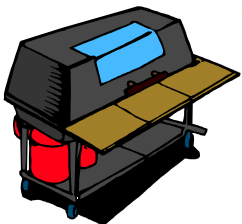

Pour heated mixture over dry ingredients and stir. Place into 9"x13" pan and toast for 20 minutes at 325 degrees, stirring several times. When it is cool, you may add raisins, dates, or figs. (Store in refrigerator if coconut is added.)

It makes a nutritious snack. Try eating some fresh strawberries, blueberries, or peaches with granola!

GAS GRILLING SAFETY TIPS:



- Propane and charcoal BBQ grills should only be used outdoors.
- The grill should be placed well away from the home, deck railings and out from under eaves and overhanging branches.
- Keep your grill clean by removing grease or fat buildup from the grills and in trays below the grill.
- Never leave your grill unattended.
- Always store propane tanks outside.
