RESSLERS FAVORITE RECIPE

Apple and Cheddar Stuffed Chicken with Dijon Mustard Sauce

4 chicken breasts1 apple peeled and chopped

1/2 c. yellow shredded cheddar cheese

2 tsp. lemon juice

1/2 tsp. thyme + a pinch, divided

1/4 tsp. oregano salt and pepper

1/4 c. flour
2 Tbsp. Extra Virgin Olive Oil
3/4 c. chicken broth
1/2 c. apple juice
2 Tbsp. Dijon mustard
1 1/2 tsp. apple cider vinegar

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Directions: Preheat oven to 375 degrees. Cut a horizontal pocket into each chicken breast. Set aside. Mix apples, cheese, lemon juice, 1/2 tsp. thyme, oregano, salt and pepper. Stuff chicken with mixture and close with toothpicks.

Heat EVOO in a large skillet, combine flour, salt and pepper. Dredge chicken breasts in the flour mixture. Tap off excess flour. Place chicken in skillet and sauté until golden brown. (About 4-5 mins on each side.) Place on baking sheet and cook in oven for 20 minutes. Meanwhile mix apple juice, chicken broth, mustard, apple cider vinegar and a pinch of thyme. Add to same skillet. Cook until reduced. About 5 minutes. Drizzle over chicken.

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BENEFITS TO EMAIL INVOICES AND DELIVERY RECEIPTS

Customers of **Ressler Propane** can now receive email delivery of invoices and statements which gives the advantage of a fifty cent reduction to payments if the invoice is paid by the due date.

Recently we made changes to our delivery processes and can now offer customers the opportunity to receive a delivery confirmation via e-mail. Immediately following a delivery to your residence or business, an email confirmation can be sent to your phone, tablet or computer. The confirmation includes date and time of delivery, the number of gallons delivered, and the location address of the delivery. As usual, billing for the delivery will be sent as requested the next business day, either by e-mail or standard mail.

WHAT IS THE DANGER OF CARBON MONOXIDE?

Carbon Monoxide, commonly known as "CO", is a colorless, odorless, and tasteless gas produced by the incomplete burning of fuels such as coal, wood, charcoal, natural gas, propane or oil. If appliances burning these fuels are used correctly and are in good working order, the amount of CO produced is not hazardous.

Low levels of CO can cause shortness of breath, mild nausea and headaches. Moderate levels can cause severe headaches, nausea, fainting, and mental confusion. Extended exposure may have long-term effects on your health. If you suspect CO poisoning, get fresh air immediately. Open doors and windows, turn off appliances and leave the house. Call 911 and go to an emergency room to report possible poisoning.

CO poisoning can be prevented by following these guidelines:

 Have your heating system, water heater, and any other gas, oil, or coal-burning appliances inspect-

- ed and serviced by a qualified technician on a regular basis.
- Install a battery-operated CO detector in your home and check or replace the battery when you change the time on your clocks each spring and fall.
- Seek prompt medical attention if you suspect CO poisoning and are feeling dizzy, light-headed or nauseated.
- Do not use a generator, charcoal grill, camp stove, or other gasoline or charcoal-burning device inside your home, basement, and garage or near a window.
- Do not run a car or truck inside a garage attached to your house, even if you leave the garage door open
- Do not burn any thing in a stove or fireplace that is not properly vented.
- Do not heat your home with a gas oven or gas dryer, or a portable camping or construction heater designed to be used outside or in a well ventilated space.



ENERGY ASSISTANCE

Ressler Propane is once again participating in the Low-Income Home Energy Assistance Program (LIHEAP) offered by the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania for the 2016-2017 heating season. The program helps many families cover the cost of home heating and we encourage customers to contact LIHEAP if they are experiencing financial difficulties.

LIHEAP is a grant and does not have to be repaid. However, to qualify you must meet LIHEAP's income guidelines. Tired of worrying about checking your tank gauge on a cold or snowy day? Have you ever remembered to look at your tank gauge and then forgotten to call in or submit an online request for an order? If you haven't already taken advantage of our "Scheduled Delivery" service, you may not know what you're missing!

Ressler Propane offers many different types of "Scheduled Deliveries". For most heating accounts, we offer an "Automatic" delivery program that calculates your usage based on previous history and the outside air temperature.

If you have a sporadically used appliance such as a pool heater, gas logs, generator or fire-pit, we offer "Scheduled Deliveries" based on your needs. These deliveries are tailored to meet your needs and occur each year at the same time based on your past consumption.

Water heating and cooking-only accounts will use a schedule with a specific period of time between each

delivery, for example, every 30, 90 or 180 days. For the very unpredictable user, we even offer remote tank monitoring. This can come with an additional charge, but will guarantee you never run out of propane. Please contact Bryce or Lenny in our sales office to discuss this feature.

The biggest benefit to any type of "Scheduled Delivery" is that you NEVER pay for extra costs incurred if we let you run out of Propane. This is one less thing for you to worry about. You have better things to do and we take pride and satisfaction in keeping our "Scheduled Delivery" customers


BE PREPARED

After a record breaking summer of 90 degree plus days, it's hard to think of freezing temperatures and snow falls, but winter is upon us. Ressler Propane wants our customers to be prepared for the winter

and uncertain weather conditions that accompany the colder months of the season.

- Please keep your driveway clear of snow and ice.
- Please clear snow and ice away from above and underground tanks, as well as the regulators. A brightly colored flag or stake at least 30 inches high next to underground tanks is greatly appreciated as well as a path to the tank. If the tank is

located within a fenced enclosure, please have the gate unlocked and snow cleared away from the entrance so the gate can open properly.



ly if your usage is sporadic. Please contact our office if the level of propane in your tank is below 30%. Please remember to notify our office if you add or remove any gas appliances within your existing propane system.

• For customers with a propane powered generator, please contact our office if the generator has been operating for 24 hours or more. We will give priority to customers whose tanks are at a low level and whose generators have been running over 24 hours. We will attempt to make the delivery as soon as possible,

weather permitting.

As always, please call our office immediately if you suspect a gas leak.
